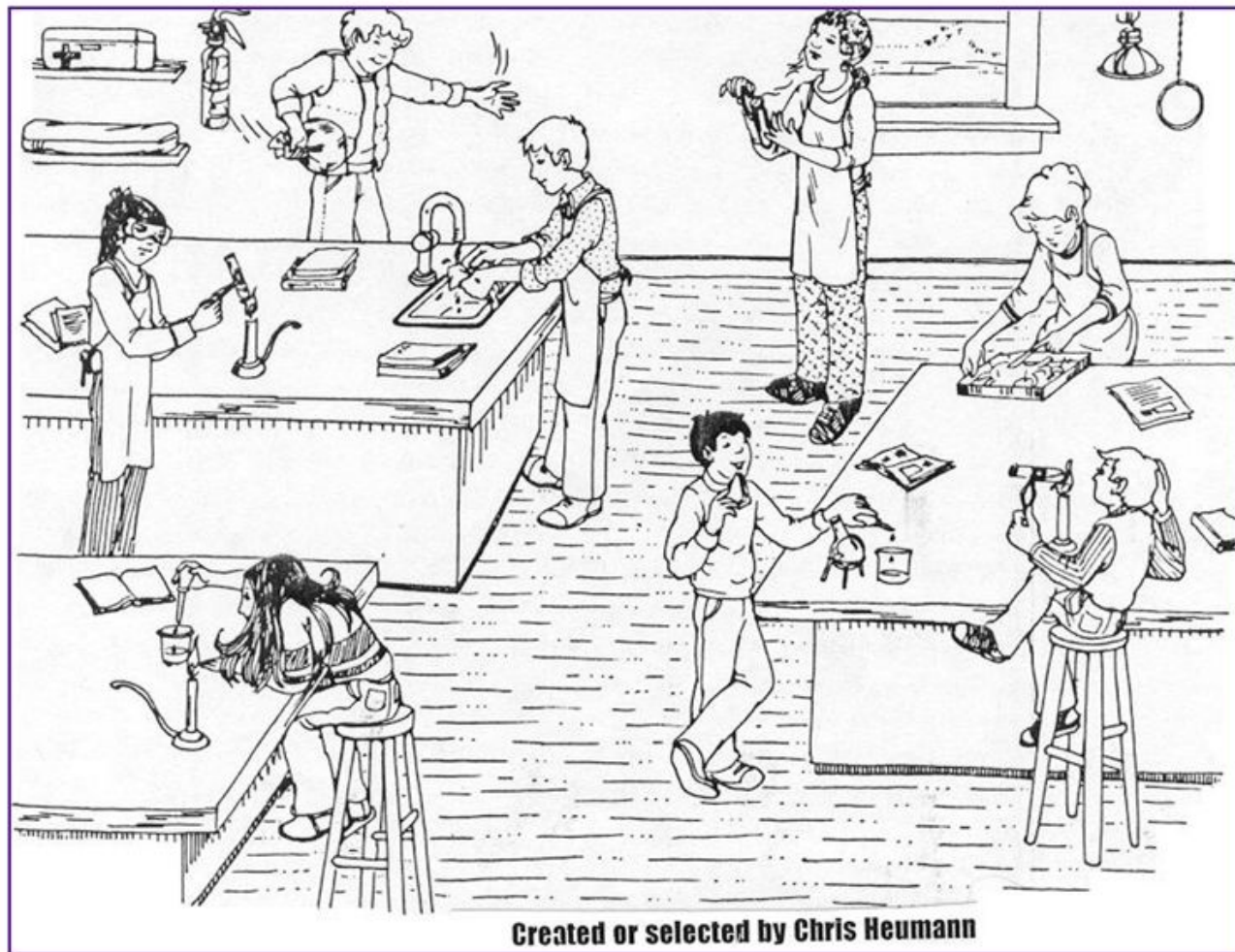
# Lab Safety Rules
